The house is operated by Danubian District of the Reformed Church in Hungary. The unique spirit and qualities of this place make it an ideal venue for Christian groups. However, its accommodations and conference facilities are also available for other organisations interested in using the space for tourism or professional events. We warmly welcome individual travelers and tourists subject to availability.

Our fully equipped conference halls are available for groups of various sizes, ranging from 20-50 to 100-400 people. The chapel with seating for up to 50 people can serve as a place for quiet contemplation, while the restaurant area is ideal for group meals, and social gatherings.

Thanks to its excellent location, Ráday House offers easy access to Budapest’s most famous sights, including the National Museum, the banks of the river Danube, city’s renowned Market Hall, Gellért Hill, and many other attractions. These can be conveniently reached on foot, or by use of city’s public transportation system.

The double rooms of the residence feature a private balcony, en-suite bathroom, and air-conditioning. Each room is also equipped with a desk and a refrigerator, and Wi-Fi is available throughout the building.

The house is easily accessible by public transport or car. The nearest airport is Budapest Ferenc Liszt International Airport, which is 12 km away from the accommodation. We can accommodate up to 100 guests at a time.
